

Strawberry Cheesecake Lasagna

- 2 (8 oz) packages cream cheese, softened
- 3/4 cup <u>Imperial Sugar Extra Fine</u>

 <u>Granulated Sugar</u>
- 2 cups heavy whipping cream
- 1/2 cup <u>Imperial Sugar</u>

 <u>Confectioners Powdered Sugar</u>
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 box graham crackers
- 2 pounds fresh strawberries, diced
- 1. Using an electric mixer beat cream cheese and sugar together until smooth and creamy. Pour into a separate bowl and set aside. 1
- 2. Whip heavy cream, using the whisk attachment of a mixer, until you have soft peaks. Add powdered sugar and vanilla. Whip until stiff peaks.2
- 3. Fold whipped cream into cream cheese mixture.
- 4. Place a single layer of graham crackers into the bottom of a 13x9-inch baking dish. Spread 1/2 of the whipped cream mixture over the crackers. Add 1/2 the strawberries. Repeat with another layer of crackers and the remaining cream and strawberries. 4
- 5. Place in fridge for 4-5 hours before serving.

The Monday before the Great Commission Conversation, those who have signed up will receive the information to join the meeting using Zoom.


This is Fish Fry month. So please be praying for this ministry that someone might get saved. This is an awesome ministry.
